

HOW TO LINK FROM THE EQUIPD BIBLE APP TO A PAGE IN THE ONENOTE APP

Things You Will Need

Equipd Bible App for the iPad

Microsoft OneNote Desktop Version

Microsoft OneNote iPad Version

OneNote is a great place to save pictures, articles, snippets of text, or create new documents. It is a great place to make notebooks for the assemblies and conventions or take notes at the meetings.


If you would like to be able to link from a scripture in your Equipd Bible App to a "page" in your MS OneNote notebook you can do it now.

You need to setup OneNote so that you can use it on your desktop and it syncs to your iPad version.

Hopefully one day the iPad version of OneNote will have the same linking capabilities that the desktop version has.

Directions

1. Open your **desktop version of OneNote** to the page that you would like Equipd to link to.



In my example, 40-Matthew is the section and Horned Viper is the page.

Right click on the page in the right column that you want to link to (i.e. Horned Viper).

A menu comes up. Choose **"Copy Link to Page"**.

Go to the bottom of your page and right click where you want to paste the link. A menu comes up. Select **"Paste Options"**. Choose the third option **"Keep Text Only (T)"**. It has an A on it.

It will look like this after you paste it:



There are really two links there. You want to delete the first or top one so that this is what you have left.

It will start with onenote and end with &end.


So you have now created a link for the page.




2. Now open your iPad version of OneNote. Make sure your copies have synced.

Locate your page that you created the link for.

Tap on the link. It will be in blue. Select **“Copy”**.



3. Now open **Equipd Bible**. Go to the scripture that you want to link from. Tap on the number so that the note box appears. Paste your link into it. Close the note. See how the link name changed to the name of the page (i.e. Horned Viper).
